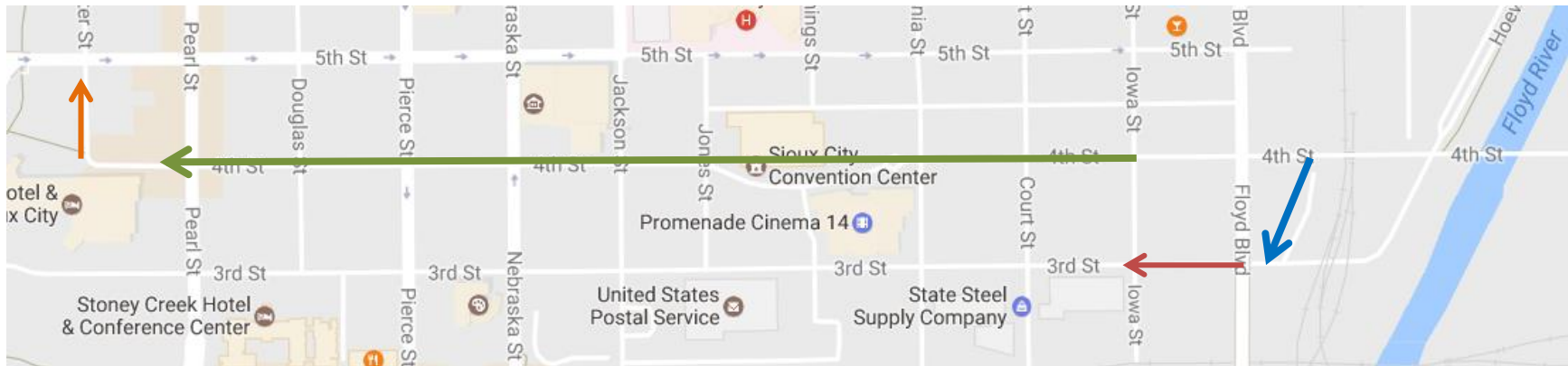




Thank you for participating in the Sioux City St. Patrick's Day Parade! Below is information about the parade.



Arrival

Please arrive to line-up for the parade beginning at 2 p.m. on Sunday, March 17.

Line-up Zone

The line-up zone is on 3rd Street between Floyd and Iowa Street (see red arrow above). The best way to reach this zone is to go south on Hoey Drive off of 4th St. to travel under the Floyd Blvd. viaduct (blue arrow above). 3rd Street will be blocked and not available for U-turns.

Parade Progress

Once the parade starts, you must keep up with the group ahead of you. Stopping to pass out items or perform is not allowed. Please keep the parade moving. Do not leave a gap of more than 15 feet between you and the group in front of you. If you are throwing candy, beads or other items, please take extreme care of the children crowding your vehicle. You must throw things far enough to keep children out of harms way.

End of Parade

The parade is done after crossing Pearl Street. Please keep your vehicle moving or pull to the side so the parade does not get backed up. We recommend turning on Water and going to 5th Street (orange arrow above) to return to the start or to your group's meeting spot.
